## **A.V.C. College - an Introduction:**

The Anbanathapuram Vahaira Charities was established in 1806 by the philanthropic members of five families belonging to Anbanathapuram, Enathimangalam, Pallavarayanpettai, Karugudi, and Kanganamputhur. Since its inception, the A.V. Charities has been serving humanity in the fields of religion and charitable activities. In 1955, the Charities established A.V.C. College to Serve the cause of higher education.

The institution has grown from strength to strength and has developed into a Postgraduate and Research Institution. The Autonomous status was conferred by the UGC in 1987 and has been extended up to the academic year 2031–32 and currently is affiliated to the Annamalai University, Annamalai Nagar - 608 002.

The College has been reaccredited with an “A+” Grade (CGPA: 3.46/4.00) by NAAC in the fourth cycle. The College has also been awarded the status of “College with Potential for Excellence – Phase I & II” by the UGC.

The College has been ranked in the Rank-band: 151-200 at all over India by National Institutional Ranking Framework during NIRF-2025, and was placed continuously in the rank band since 2018, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India, New Delhi.

Men students are admitted in all under-graduate courses. Women students are also admitted, except B.Sc. Computer Science and B.Com. Both men and women students are admitted in all the PG courses. The College offers the following Under-Graduate, Post-Graduate courses and Research Programmes in the Day College under semester pattern with Choice Based Credit System (CBCS).

## **APPLICATION :**

B.A. / B.Sc. / B.Com. / M.A. / M.Sc. / M.Com. - Application form to be filled through A.V.C. College (Autonomous) website with payment of prescribed fees.

The filled application should be submitted to "The Principal, A.V.C. College (Autonomous), Mannampandal, Mayiladuthurai - 609 305" in person or by Registered Post.

The candidate should apply through online using the College website.

The candidates should fill in the application form carefully, without any mistake and omission of any column by following the instructions given. One application alone should be submitted with choices and order of his/her preferences for various courses. Printed filled in application should be signed by the applicant and his/her parent or guardian. **Make sure that the email address and cell phone numbers are correct which will be used for further correspondence.**

Incomplete applications / application with wrong / insufficient information will be summarily rejected and late application will not be considered for admission.

The College reserves the right to call or not to call any applicant for counselling. The fact that a candidate has submitted an application for a course does not entitle him/her to attend counselling. Being attended the counselling is not an assurance for admission.

Original Certificates should not be sent with application form. However, candidates seeking admission in Special category such as Sports / NCC / NSS / Differently abled / Ex-service men have to attach xerox copies of the proof along with their application forms.

Applicants are advised to take sufficient number of copies of the Transfer Certificate, Mark Sheets and Degree Certificates for their use before surrendering them to the college office at the time of admission. Certificates will not be returned to the students during the course of study on any account.

Printout of online filled in application form for U.G. Courses should be sent to The Principal, A.V.C. College (Autonomous), Mannampandal, Mayiladuthurai - 609305.

## **ADMISSION:**

Candidates are asked to attend the counselling as per the eligible schedule which is given in the website. Based on HSC marks / UG marks - merit cum communal reservation policy is followed. Student should come with his/her parents or guardian (as guarantor of the student for his/her study only) for attending the counselling.

## **NOTE:**

1. Upper age limit for admission to UG courses will be 21 years as on 1st July 2026. However, a relaxation of 5 years is permitted for Differently Abled. SC/ST/SCA/BC/BCM/MBC/DNC and women candidates may be allowed the age relaxation of 3 years beyond 21 years for the admission into UG Courses and no age limit for PG Courses.
2. Student should submit the following original certificates, with attested Xerox copies (2 nos.), three passport size photographs and two stamp size photos of parents /guardians during counselling.
  - Qualifying examination mark sheet/ provisional mark sheet attested by the head of the institution last studied.
  - Transfer certificate (TC), Mark sheet and Community certificate [Among these three certificates the Name, Date of Birth, Reg. No. and TMR code in the mark list, father/mother name, community and caste name in community certificate should be consistent. If there is any inconsistency in these details admission will not be considered].
  - Conduct certificate, if not included in TC
  - Appropriate certificates for special quota [for applicable cases]
3. Student should remit the required fees immediately, if selected in the counselling.
4. Admission will be rejected for those who are unable to produce the original certificates during counselling and also who fails to remit the required fees immediately.
5. No time extension will be given for the submission of original certificates and remittance of required fees.
6. Those who are not able to pay the fees or submit the original certificates on the day of counselling, will forfeit their admission automatically.
7. Fees once paid are not refundable on any account.
8. Those admitted to the Day College will not be transferred to the Evening section and *vice-versa* on any account. Change of course (from one major to another) will not be allowed.
9. Physically challenged candidates should produce the original Identity card issued by the Government for persons with disabilities with all the details including percentage of disabilities at the time of counselling.
10. Relevant original documentary evidence should be produced by the candidate who claims admission under Ex-servicemen category, Sports, and NCC at the time of counselling.
11. Community certificate in original should be produced at the time of counselling.
12. Admission is subject to the verification of Mark certificates by the Director of Government Examinations and if the Marks certificate is found bogus, admission is liable for cancellation. Besides, criminal action will be taken.
13. For availing scholarship the student should secure 75% of attendance is mandatory.

## **SPECIAL NOTE:**

As per the guidelines of UGC the duration of study is 3+2 years for UG courses and 2+2 years for PG courses. Hence, the student should finish the UG course on or before June 2031 and PG student on or before June 2030.

As per the affiliating Annamalai University Rules, students who have secured less than 60% of attendance cannot proceed to the subsequent semester without completing the 'failed' semester. Further, the student should repeat the respective semester in the subsequent year and should successfully complete the semester to continue the course. If a Student has secured less than 60% attendance and failed to continue I or II semester, such student cannot continue the course.

The campus is free from 'Ragging' and if anybody is found involving in ragging, as per the guidelines of UGC and Government order, a suitable legal action and immediate suspension will be initiated by the college.

## **FACILITIES AVAILABLE**

### **GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP**

All UG and PG, Students belonging to BC, MBC/DNC & SC/ST Communities are eligible for scholarship who's parents Annual income is less than Rs.2.5 lakhs.

Further, the eligible UG students can get scholarships through Tamil Nadu Government schemes viz., THAMIZH PUTHALVAN THITTAM & PUTHUMAI PEN THITTAM

### **HOSTEL**

The college has well furnished separate hostels for Men and Women students in the college campus. Application for admission to the Hostel can be obtained from the respective Hostel Office.

### **CO-OPERATIVE STORES**

Textbooks, notebooks and other Stationery items are sold in the Students' Co-operative Stores. A student admitted to the college becomes a member of the Stores and he/she has to pay 750/- as Trade Deposit for the purchase of textbooks and notebooks.

### **CONCURRENT COURSES**

The affiliating Annamalai University conducts several correspondence courses such as Diploma and Certificate programs, in which students can enroll. In addition, students can also register to undertake online courses offered through NPTEL, SWAYAM, and MOOC.

### **SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS TO SC/ST CANDIDATES (For UG Courses only)**

1. Application form for SC/ST candidates is FREE OF COST in the Day College.
2. SC/ST candidates are exempted from paying their Tuition Fees in the Day College. However, they have to remit the Lab Fees, Special Fees, Co-operative Stores Trade Deposit etc., at the time of admission.

### **SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS TO BC/MBC/DNC CANDIDATES (For UG Courses only)**

Parents Income less than Rupees Two Lakhs are eligible for the award of government scholarship.

## **PEKAK EXTENSION ACTIVITIES**

The students have to undergo PEKAK Extension Activities in their first year of U. G. studies in selected villages on awareness programmes.

## **PART-V: ACTIVITIES**

The College offers Sports, NCC, NSS, Rotaract Club, Leo Club, Junior Jaycees Club, Students Exnora, Fine Arts, RRC, YRC and USSC. U.G. students have to enroll themselves atleast in one of these activities.
