PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE

The Anbanathapuram Vahaira Charities, an organization with a track record of more than two centuries was established in 1806 by the philanthropic members of the five families of Anbanathapuram, Enathimangalam, Pallavarayapet, Karukudi and Kanganamputhur. In 1955, the A.V. Charities established the A.V.C. College to serve the cause of higher education. Now the College is administrated by the Judge Administrator, Honourable Justice Mr. K. Venkataraman. The institution was established with 120 students in intermediate class, which has now grown into a Post-Graduate and Research institution with a current strength of 4506 students which includes 2548 women students, and 112 Ph.D. Scholars. Our college offers 23 Under-Graduate, 17 Post-Graduate degree programmes, and 10 Ph.D., research programmes.

Now 245 teaching and 116 non-teaching staff are serving in the College. Autonomous status was conferred on us 1987 and since then the college has taken innovative steps and measures in the areas of teaching, learning, evaluation, research and extension activities. I am happy to record that our college has been awarded 'A+' Grade by NAAC with CGPA of 3.46/4.00 in 4th Cycle in the recent peer team visit. I am very proud to state here that our College has been awarded the status of "College with Potential for Excellence" (Phase-II), a very rare honour offered by UGC. Our College has been placed in the Rank Band 101-150 by NIRF Ranking in 2024 by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India and the same position is retained for the last seven years.

INTERNAL COMPLAINTS COMMITTEE (ICC)

- An awareness program about Government Social Welfare Schemes was held on 05.07.2024 in the A.V. Hall, Department of Economics. Dr. Deepa Moorthy, DMC of Mayiladuthurai district addressed the students. She made her session an interactive one, enabling the students to shed their inhibition. Students came to know about various schemes available for girl children, differently abled children, destitute women etc... Dr. Deepa gave useful tips to crack the competitive exams. More than 80 students attended the program. Principal Dr. R. Nagarajan, ICC members and a few officials from the Social Welfare department, Mayiladuthurai district graced the occasion.
- The Internal Complaints Committee conducted an awareness program on "Save Girl Children and Educate Girl Children". The program was held in association with the Social Welfare Department on 03.10.2024, between 2.30 p.m and 3.30 p.m in the A.V.Hall of the department of Economics. Mr. P. Anbudasan, Gender specialist, acted as the resource person. He talked about cyber crimes and abuse of girl children prevailing in the society. He mentioned the helpline numbers and advised the students to be alert of such crimes. He insisted on the importance of the education of the girls. A total number of 51 students benefited from the program.
- The Internal Complaints Committee and the Department of Visual Communication of A.V.C. College(Autonomous) in association with the Mayiladuthurai District Hub for Empowerment of Women organised a program for women empowerment. Mrs. S. She spoke about the role of ICC in assisting the victims of harassment. Dr. M. Kanimozhi, psychologist, spoke about crisis management. Mrs. S. Angayargani and Mrs. K. Bhuvaneshwari from One Stop Centre highlighted the schemes offered by the Government of Tamilnadu for Women Empowerment and 71 students and six staff members attended the sessions.
- Women's day was celebrated in association with the department of History on 07.03.2025 in Room no. 82. Dr. Santhi, Head of the department of History welcomed the gathering. Principal Dr. R. Nagarajan delivered the presidential address. He recognised the role of women in the achievements of men. He advised the students not

to yield to the temptations of social media. Dr. R. Manjula was the Chief guest of the day. In her special lecture she mentioned how cautious women should be and pointed out that education is the most important one for women. She also insisted that women should use their knowledge for society. Mrs. S. Sathyabama, Coordinator of ICC made use of the occasion to bring awareness about protection, prevention and redressal of sexual harassment. Dr. P. Malarvizhi talked about the importance of self confidence. Three students from department of History expressed their views on women empowerment. The program concluded with the proposal of vote of thanks by Dr. P. Gayathri, member of ICC. Faculty members from various departments and ICC members graced the occasion. Nearly 120 students attended the program.

LIBRARY

The total number of Books are 97,054 which includes the addition of 94 books for the academic year 2024-2025. The Total amount spent for the purchase of Books in this year is Rs.64,979/-. In-addition, there are 20 Periodicals were subscribed. The amount spent towards the subscription of Journals for this year is Rs.23,870/-.

Our Library is a regular Member of DELNET & UGC, N-LIST Databases.

Moreover through Library and Information centre the Elocution Competition and Essay Writing Competition (both Tamil and English) were conducted on 11-03-2025 & 12-03-2025 for the benefits of Students and prizes will be distributed to the winners during College Day Function along with prizes for two Best Library Users.

HOSTEL

Our college Hostel provides accommodation for both men and women separately. Also Administrator is generous in providing free boarding and lodging for differently abled students, outstanding sports persons in our Men's Hostel.

HIGHER EDUCATION FOR PERSONS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS (HEPSN)

Our college and Administrator provide free boarding and lodging and exempts the payment of examination fee for students with special needs.

HEPSN has rendered a yeomen service to the disabled students of our college. There are 38 differently abled students studying in our college both in UG and PG levels. Among the 38 students 12 of them are visually impaired. Our magnanimous administrator is kind enough to provide free boarding and lodging and exempted the payment of college tuition fee. The organization has arranged scribe assistance during the test and

examinations days. Our college finance committee has granted rupees 200 per session towards the scribe remuneration. They have applied for Tamil Nadu Social Welfare Scholarship and National Scholarship for Persons with Disability. They have received a sum of Rs. 1,60,000 [One Lakh and Sixty Thousand]. They have received Android mobile phone. A special software called Talk Back is installed in these mobile phones. It helped the user to listen and identify the icon through voice recognition. Tamil Nadu Government Social Welfare department has issued Smart National ID card to all the differently abled students.

SCHOLARSHIPS & GRANTS

During 2024-25, 1793 students applied and received Rs. 33,54,303/- for the scholarship in different heads which were distributed directly through students' bank accounts.

Under "Pudhumai Penn" Scheme of Tamil Nadu Government totally 757 female students are receiving Rs. 1,000/- every month.

Under "Tamizh Pudhalvan" Scheme of Tamil Nadu Government totally 707 Male students are receiving Rs. 1,000/- every month.

Honourable administrator magnanimously sanctioned fees waiver of a sum of Rs. 4,99,735 for 78 sports students who represented international and university level sports and games.

A sum of Rs. 2,14,115/- was received as Private scholarship for 15 students from various organizations/Trust/well-wishers., etc.
