### Instructions of Authors

## The Preparation of Manuscripts

MAYUR, the journal of Science and Humanities of A.V.C.College (Autonomous) publishes papers and short communications concerned with all aspects of records. with all aspects of research carried out by the Faculty Members, Research Scholars and Students of Science and Humanities.

## Submission of Manuscripts

The manuscripts should be submitted both as Hard Copy and also as Electronic Copy. All the manuscripts should be submitted in A4 paper size

Type, Style and Size The manuscripts should be typed in Times Roman (Font Size 11 points) and 1.5 line space. The legends to figures and tables and all tabular metables and all tabular metables. tables and all tabular materials should be typed in 11 point

Lay out

Justification

All text should be fully justified.

Line Spacing

Scripts must be typed with 1.5 line spacing.

New Paragraphs

Don't indent text at the start of each paragraph

Paragraph Spacing

There should be 1 line space after heading and paragraphs of text. However, there should be 2

Line spaces before the start of new first category heading.

Title

Type this in Bold and as per case letters, don't end title in a full stop.

Author(s) Name

Type authors name in Case Letters

Authors' Addresses

Type in normal with Leading Capitals Only; no full stops

Heading

Type all First Level Headings in Upper Case Bold Letters. The following those more likely to be required. Abstract, Introduction, Study Area and Materials and Methods, Results,

Discussion, Acknowledgement and References, Type any Second Level Headings in normal

type (but avoid their use if at all possible)

Abstract

This should be indented by 10mm on both the Left and Right Margin and as with the rest of the

text fully justified. The heading Abstract should also be indented. Font Size 10 Point.

#### Tables, Charts and Diagrams

All Tables, Charts and Diagrams should be clearly set out and as concise as possible. They should be centered on the page. Neat and Legible diagrammes are to be presented. Please consider how things will look after the script has been reduced in size and reproduced. Legends for Figures and Tables should clearly describe the data presented. Table should have Horizontal line at the top, bottom and following the sub heading, horizontal lines within the body of the table should be included only where absolutely necessary.

#### Study Area and Methods

This section should clearly describe how the experiment, survey, work, etc, was carried out. It should be in sufficient detail such that the study could be repeated by any one reading the paper.

#### Preparation of Manuscript

The research paper should by structured as follows

- 1. Title: The Should not be more than t25 words long
- 2. Author(s) The Title should fallow with the name(s) of the authors with full address. Give e-mail address of the author(s)
- Abstract: Abstract of not more than 200 words informative type, outlining information from the introduction, materials and methods, Results and discuss ion but not detailed results.
- 4. Introduction, 5. Materials and Methods, 6. Results, 7. Discussion, 8. Acknowledge (Optional). 9. References, 10. Table, 11. Figures.

Nomenclature; Use common names of Animals and Plants, giving scientific names in italics on first mention

Numbers: Use SI units for measurements (m,km,g,ha,h) with a space between the numbers and unit of measurements. Give measurements in figures. e.g. 10 mm, 5ha, except at the beginning of a sentence. Spell out numbers and 10 if not a unit of measurements unless part of series containing numbers 10 or 1 e.g. 14 adults male, 23 adult females and three juveniles

References: Use the author, Year, Method of citing and listing references, in the text citing two authors: (Anderson and Wilson, 2000) or Anderson and Willson (2000), cite more the n two authors (Anderson et.al, 2000) or Anderson et .al, (2000) in the references- list cite and publications as fallows.

Write out articles an edited books as - Dopson, A.P. and May, R.M. 1986. Disease and Conservation. In Conservation Biology (ed), M.E.Soule) Sinaur Associates, Senderland, M.A. pp.123-142.

Journal, Articles as - Anderson, W.1998. Elephants, Selective Logging and Forest Regeneration in the Kidale Forest, Uganda, Journal of Tropical Ecology, 12.45- 54. Book References as Copy, M.L.1985 Habitat Selection in Birds. Academic Press, London. Arrange the References in Alphabetical Order.

# GUIDE LINES FOR CONTRIBUTORS (SOCIAL SCIENCES)

- 1. Manuscripts should be submitted in duplicate. They must be typed on one side only, double spaced, with sufficient margins on all sides (Autonomous), Mannampandal -609 305.
- 2. Notes should be consecutively numbered and presented at the end of the article, not at the foot each page (even though they will eventually be printed as footnotes)
- 3. Use British rather than American Spellings.
- 4. Table: No vertical lines to be used. All tables to carry a source at the bottom. References to tables in the text to be made by their numbers, e.g., "See Table -3) and not page number.
- Quotations should start on a separate line and be indented; shorter quotation should be run into the text, within single quotation marks
- Referencing Style
  - A. For Published sources the following examples illustrate the style be followed:
    - (a) Books:

    - (b) Edited Volumes:

    - (d) Articles in Edited Volumes:
      - S. Weber, 'Demarcations; Deconstruction, institutionalization and ambivalence; in G. Lenz and K. Shell, Eds, The Crisis of Modernity, Frankfurt and Boulder, 1986, P. 302.

On subsequent reference this will become: Sridhar, The Guile Lineage, Chap, 4 (Note: The use of op.Cit. and loc.Cit is to be completely avoided.)

- 7. Primary source citations must include the archival location, including the town and if necessary, the country where an archive is located, at first use, Each major series within an archive should have a separate abbreviation. For official sources mention department, branch, file number, year and month in this order. In case recorded oral materials stored in audio archives are being used, the location of the recordings should be specified. In other cases, the name and location of the oral information should be clearly stated in possible. For inscriptions, please cite full title of volume at first use.
- 8. Articles should be typed on bond paper with wide margins and sent in duplicate (A4 size). All matter including quotations to be indented and footnotes should be types in double space. Number footnotes serially and types them separately; include references to literature within footnotes.
- 9. Articles submitted to the journal should be original contributions and should not be under consideration for any other publication at the same time; if at article is under consideration by another publication, authors should say so at the time of submission. Regarding the articles in Terminology Style Sheet of PULAMAI is recommended to follow. TAMIL NADAIK KAIYEETU (2001) is recommended to follow t give the footnotes references and bibliography.
